I'm getting in touch about the NHS and Care Volunteer Responders (NHSCVR) programme, to let you know that our volunteers are ready to support your patients this winter through the Check In and Chat service. This free service provides friendly phone calls from volunteers, offering companionship and support to those who may feel isolated or in need of a little extra connection.

Research shows these calls can make a meaningful difference, with 42% of people surveyed saying they visit their GP less often thanks to the support they receive from Volunteer Responders. By connecting patients with this service, you can help reduce unnecessary appointments and ease pressure on your team.

Booking volunteer support is straightforward, allowing you to guickly arrange volunteer calls for the people you support.
